

INSTRUCTIONS FOR TREE PIECE #50

- A Begin at the lowest system, read from left to right, and proceed upward to the next system. Follow arrows when applicable.
- Addition/subtration process for the preceding system: add each pitch/ timbre one at a time (i.e. 1, 1+2, 1+2+3, etc.). Play the entire system; then, subtract each pitch/ timbre one at a time (i.e. 1+2+3, 1+2, 1).
- Subtraction process only (for the preceding system): Play the entire system; then, subtract each pitch/timbre one at a time (i.e. 1+2+3, 1+2, 1).
- D.B.... "Dribbling" pitch/timbre: dribble to silence. With violin, the bow is bounced (or dribbled) on the string (to the tip). Other instruments create a similar effect.
- Play a short pitch/timbre (.5- second)).
- o Play a long pitch/timbre (4+ seconds).
- B.B. For violin, bow a short pitch behind the bridge on the A string; for other instruments, create a similar timbre/squeak.
- harmonics; when the \diamond is a perfect fourth above the solid note, it sounds two octaves (15va) higher than the solid note. If a harmonic is not possible on a particular instrument, attempt to create a similar effect.
 - Play two pitches/timbres very quickly, the second higher in pitch than the first, but both being somewhat indefinite in pitch.







